Products will be judged according to USDA recommendation. Products must be shown in standard canning jars such as Kerr, Mason, or Ball. It must be standard size such as half-pint, pint, or quart. All canned foods, including jelly, must be sealed with a standard lid. No paraffin allowed. Jars with rusty bands or lids, or jars without bands will not be accepted. Exhibits must be prepared since previous fair by the person in whose name the produce is entered. No canned squash, pumpkins, potatoes or sweet potatoes will be accepted. Best of Show Awards will be given to both Senior and Junior Divisions.
